ORDER AUTHORIZING TRUSTEE TO PAY STORAGE FEES

On this day came on for consideration the Motion for Authority to Pay Storage Fees ("Motion") filed by Robert Newhouse, Trustee ("Trustee"). The Court finds that cause exists to allow the Trustee to pay the storage fees associated with the preservation of the Debtor's records. The Court further finds that the storage fees a reasonable and necessary cost of administering the estate. Accordingly, the Motion should be granted. **IT IS THEREFORE,**

ORDERED that the Trustee is authorized to use estate funds to pay the storage fees in arrears in the amount of \$1,379.00 and the monthly storage fees thereafter in the approximate amount of \$1,548.00, or twelve (12) months rent for the storage units without further order of the Court.
